POLICY NO. CP 5.4.24 DEPUTISING FOR THE MAYOR

PURPOSE To establish procedures for deputising for the Mayor.

POLICY STATEMENT

Sections 5.34 and 5.35 of the *Local Government Act 1995*, determine who should act as the Mayor when the Mayor's position is vacant, or when the Mayor is unavailable, unable or unwilling to perform the Mayor's functions.

Councillors deputising for the Mayor are not permitted to wear the Mayoral Regalia or the Chain of Office, other than for officiating at a citizenship ceremony.
