Celebrate Australia Day in the City of Gosnells with a hearty breakfast and entertainment for everyone.

Held between 8am and 11am and stretching through Gosnells Town Square, Federation Parade and Centennial Pioneer Park, the Australia Day Big Breakfast includes lots of Australian animals to meet, children's activities and bush crafts, stage performances, roving entertainment and much more.

At 10am, the Citizen of the Year Awards will be announced, recognising some of the City's most inspiring residents and community groups.

The event will bring people together to celebrate the City's diverse and vibrant community, and to acknowledge the contribution that everyone makes to our community, from First Nations People to our newest Australian citizens.

Gosnells Rotary Club will be in charge of the barbecue for the morning, with Big Breakfasts available for \$11 and small servings for \$5. Food trucks will also be available, including vegan options.

Federation Parade will be closed to traffic for the event.
