



TRANSPORT POSITION STATEMENT

COUNCIL'S POSITION

Council supports the removal of all level crossings within the City of Gosnells (see following plan for locations).

The highest priority site in the City for the removal of the level crossings is William Street, Beckenham. Removal of this crossing will reduce traffic congestion and further facilitate the development of surrounding land.

The second priority for level crossing removal is Kelvin Road, Maddington because it will reduce traffic congestion and facilitate redevelopment around the Maddington train station.

Council believes that high priority level crossings in Gosnells should be removed during shut down of the Armadale rail line.

Council notes Metronet's preferred method of level crossing removal generally involves elevated rail for economic reasons.

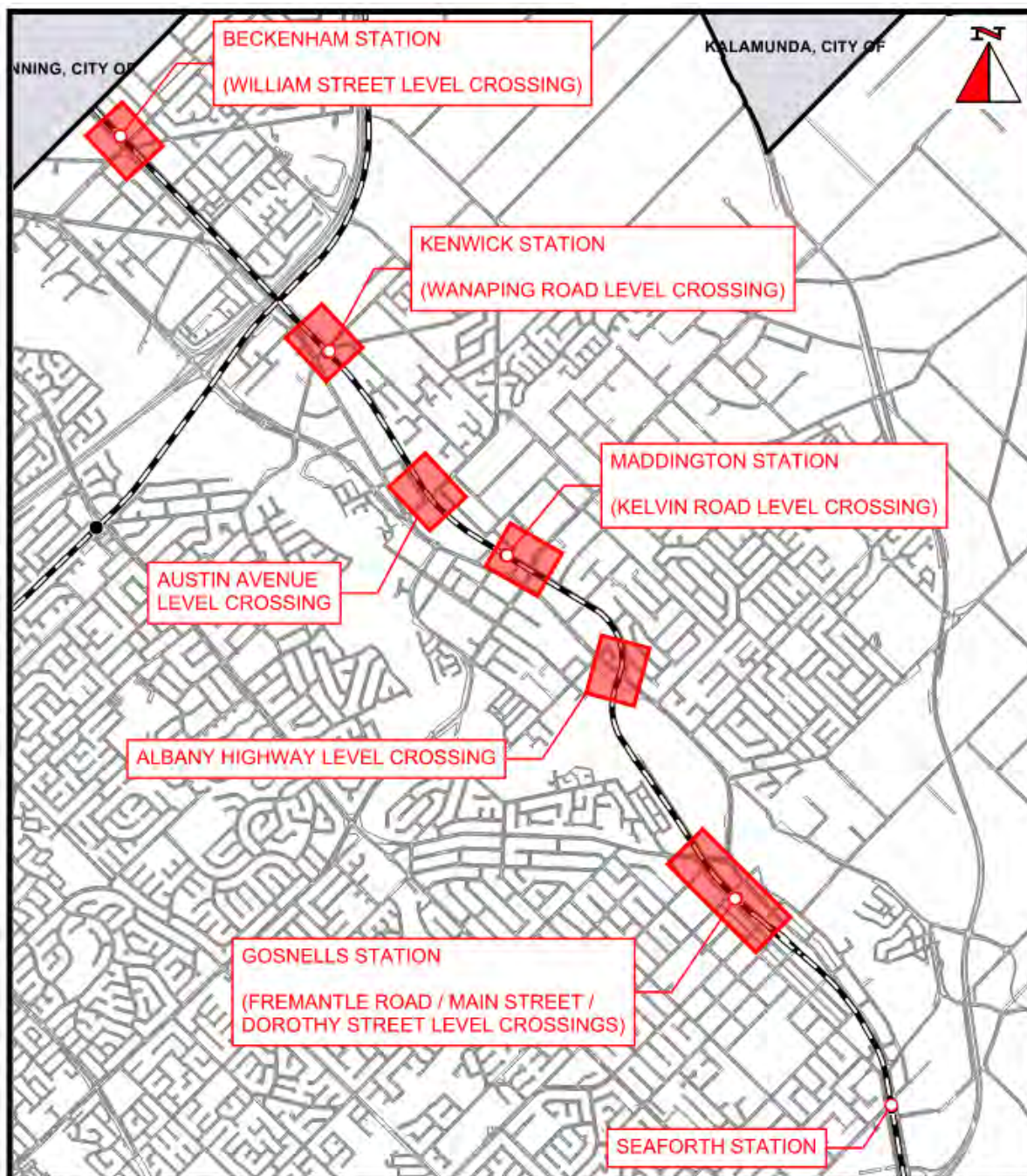
