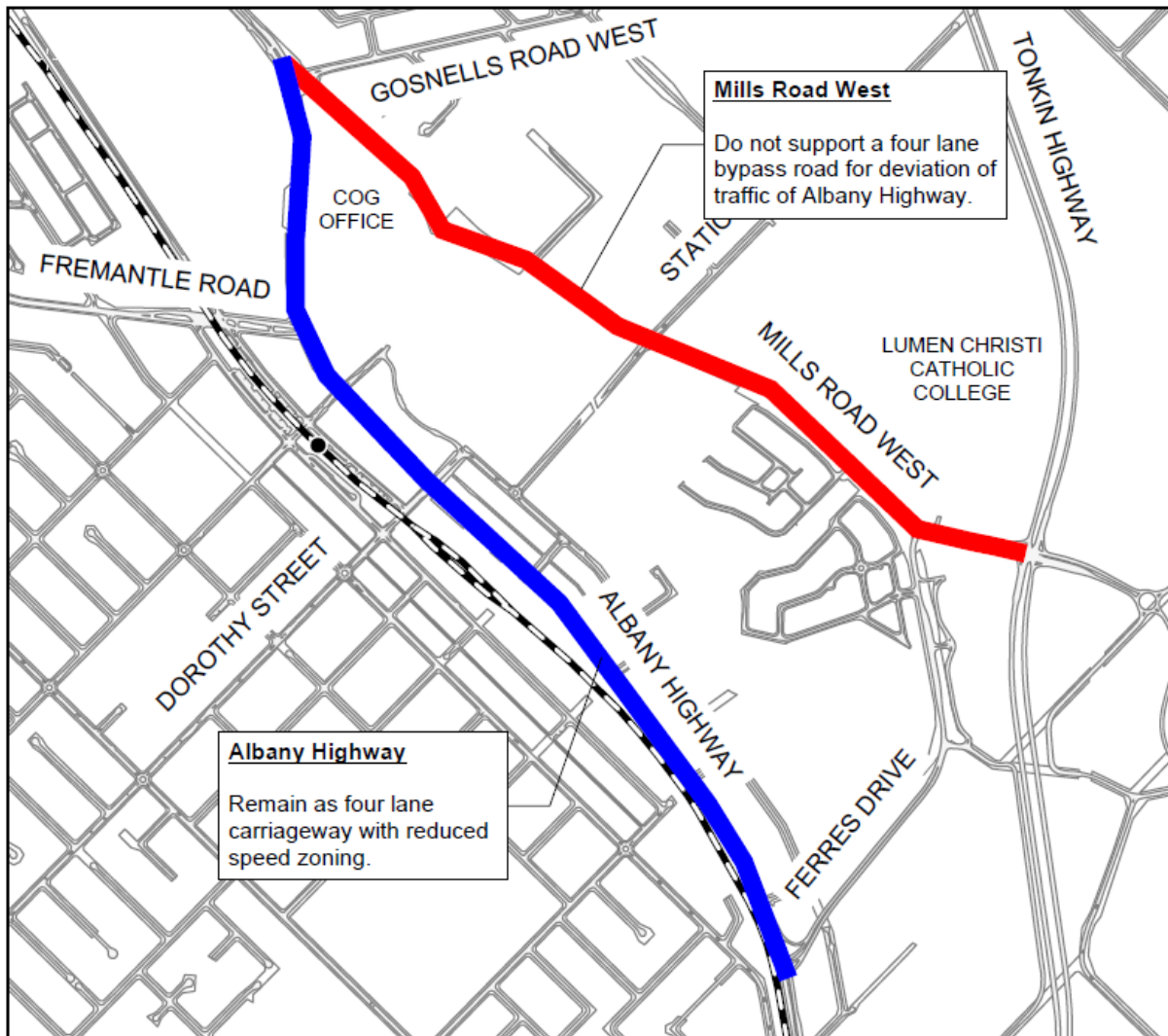




TRANSPORT POSITION STATEMENT

COUNCIL'S POSITION

Due to the reduction in vehicular traffic and the adverse impact on existing and future businesses along Albany Highway through the Gosnells Town Centre if traffic is deviated through to Tonkin Highway or Ferres Drive via Mills Road West, Council takes the following positions:

1. That Council does not support the retention of Primary Regional Road status for Mills Road West.
2. That Council does not support the Main Roads WA “Vehicle Access Strategy” for the Gosnells Town Centre, including the Mills Road West upgrade to four lanes.
3. That Council supports the development of effective treatments along Albany Highway, through the Gosnells Town Centre to reduce vehicle operating speeds and create a safer road environment.
